

MIGRANT ARRIVALS 2015 Total Arrivals: (to date) 102,802



# KEY DATA ON MIGRANT FATALITIES

The Missing Migrants Project is the only global database sharing key data on deceased and missing migrants around the world. The aim is to strengthen advocacy and support a more informed policy response.

## SUPPORTING FAMILIES OF MISSING MIGRANTS

The project empowers families of the missing by providing information and guidance, including on identification of the missing and dead, with the aim of affirming the rights and dignity of migrants and their families.

### GLOBAL INFORMATION HUB ON MIGRATION

The project underlines the global scale of the crisis by sharing key information on migrants dying along migratory routes around the world. The platform also enables feedback from migrants and families of the missing.
